Universal Free School Meals: Parents and carers may be aware that the Government has announced that from September 2014, all children in Reception and Key Stage 1 will be provided with a free school meal. The school is currently in negotiations with the Local Authority to provide the necessary equipment and accommodation to be able to meet the increased needs. In order to gain an insight into the probable take-up, please complete the form with the accompanying letter which will be sent home this week. The data needs to be sent to county by **21st May** to inform their planning: if you consider that YOU WILL NOT want a free school meal for your child then please complete and return the form to the school office by return. Parents/carers who are entitled to free school meals, as they are in receipt of benefits, should still complete the statutory form, from the school website or the office, which enables additional budget to be allocated to support the learning and access of pupils at Holy Trinity School.
