

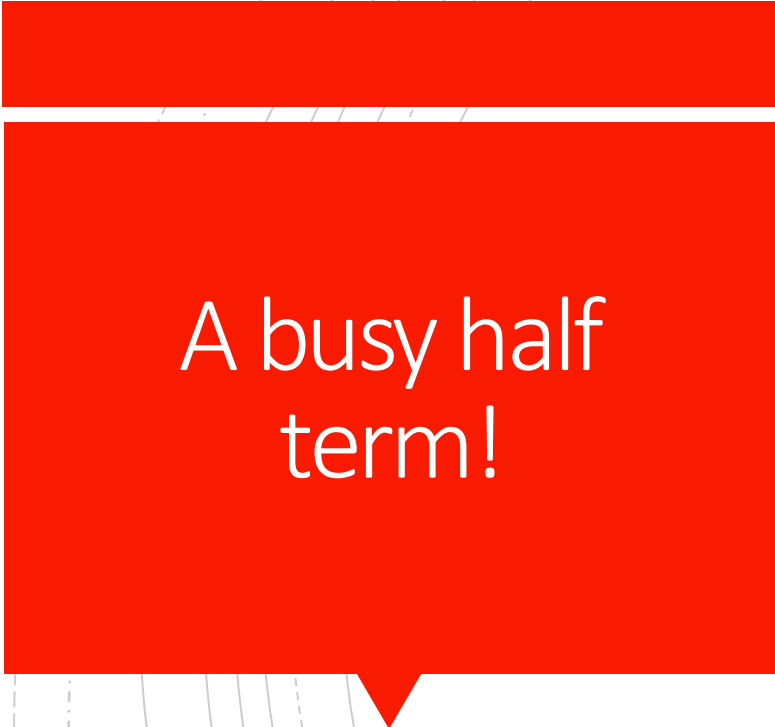

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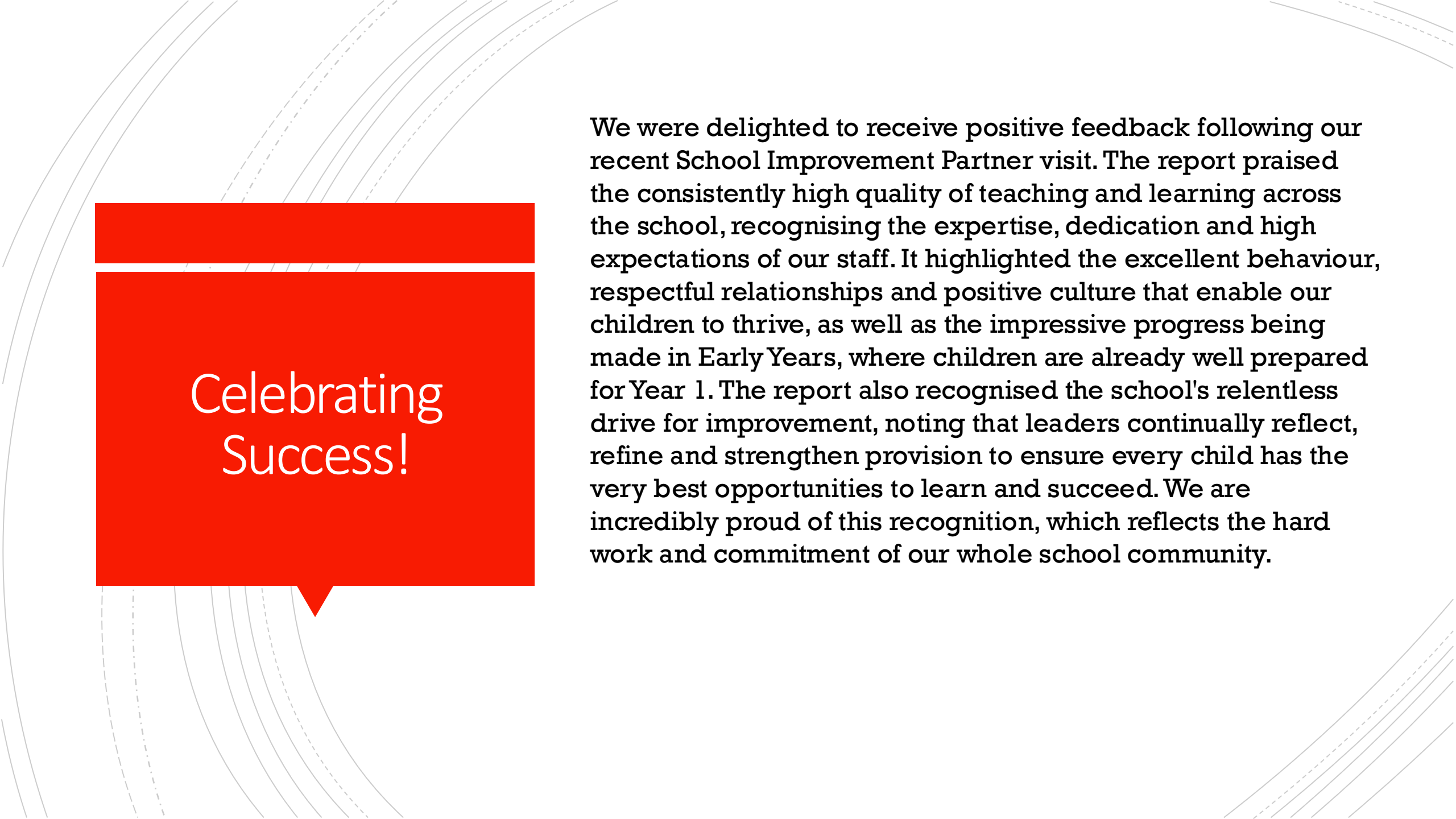

We have also been enjoying looking after our tadpoles, learning about their life cycle and finally got to see our first tiny little frog.



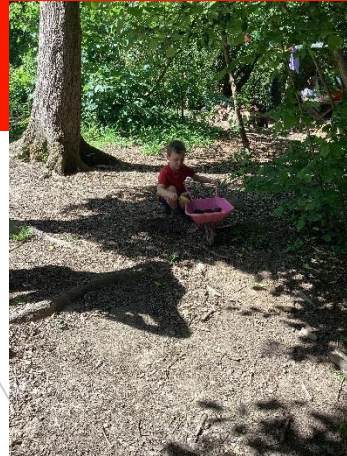

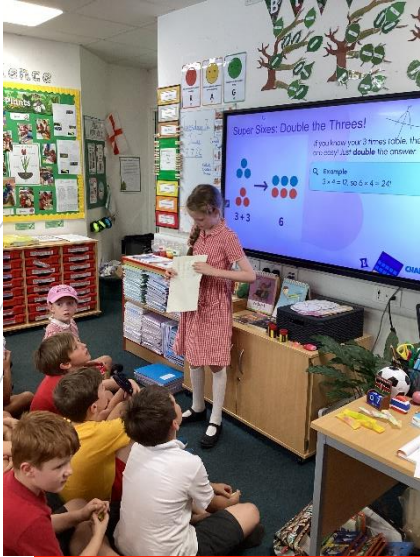

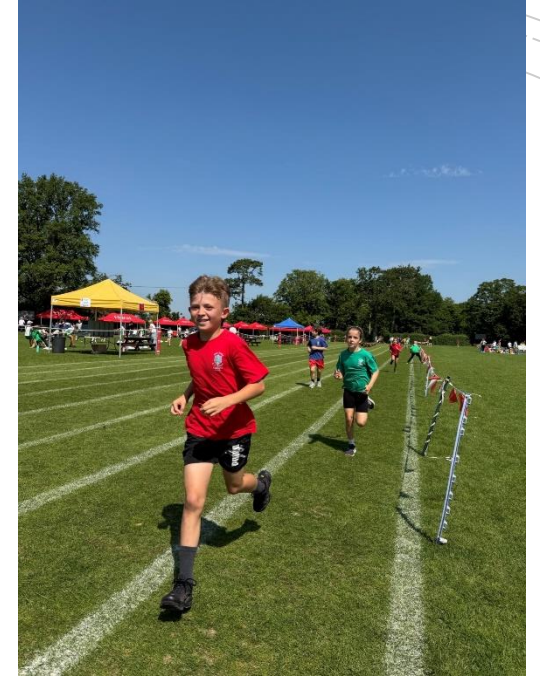
Sporting Events
