The Holy Trinity Extra-Curricular Clubs for the Spring Term are now available to book using the Sign-Up Genius website or by contacting the External Provider directly. The grids below show the range of extra-curricular activities that will be offered during the Spring Term. Some of these clubs are school run clubs which are run by either the school staff or parent volunteers whereas others are '*paid for*' clubs which are led by *External Providers*. The clubs which are run by External Providers <u>must be booked directly</u> with them and <u>not</u> via the Sign-up Genius website.

For most clubs, if your child attended during the last academic term then their place is guaranteed for the Spring Term. However, some clubs are re-opening their registers to take on new members on a first-come, first served basis.

The following clubs still have spaces available or will be offering new spaces for the Spring Term are:

## **Rising Stars Breakfast Club (External Provider)**

### Indoor Tennis (External Provider)

The club runs on Tuesday's afterschool for years 2-6 and <u>more</u> spaces are available. The current members are automatically guaranteed a place if they wish to continue but if they do not then please inform the External Provider directly. New members who are also interested will also need to contact them in order to book your child a place.

#### Infant Singing (Years 1 and 2) (External Provider)

This club runs on Fridays at lunchtime. Your child's place is guaranteed once you have successfully completed their online registration. Please note that the registration window for school run clubs will close on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

All of our other clubs will not be accepting any new pupils because they are currently full but they will be creating a waiting list for children who would like to attend the club. If your child is interested in joining one of the clubs then please use the contact details to contact the club providers directly to register your child's interest.

Children attending a club which **does not** begin directly after school are the responsibility of their parents/carers. Pupils must be supervised by a parent or nominated responsible adult and engage in a quiet activity during this time or, preferably, go home and then return for the start of the club. Collection after clubs is via the main entrance gate and through the front office.

Most clubs will start the week commencing **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2020** and the last session for clubs will be the week commencing **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020**. There may however be some exceptions to this so please refer to the individual club providers for further information. <u>Please can we remind you, that if for some reason your child will not be</u> <u>attending the club that you let the External Provider know as well as the school office using the following details (office@htprimary.co.uk) or by calling on 01444 454295.</u>

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind parents, carers and children that signing up for a club is a commitment. If your son/daughter wishes to attend an extra-curricular activity they must make every effort to attend each week. A lot of people voluntarily and willingly give up their time to run these sessions and it is most disheartening to see numbers dwindle as the term goes on. Please be responsible for notifying the organiser if your son/daughter cannot attend one week for any reason. Cancellation of school run clubs will be notified by ParentPay and external club providers should contact you directly.
