After several years in their roles, the PTA exec committee will be stepping down at the PTA AGM in January. The Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer and Secretary positions ALL need to be filled – this is a legal requirement of the PTA and if these positions are not filled, we will be taking steps to close the PTA as it can't legally continue. To then set up a new PTA in a year or two if we let this one collapse would involve a huge amount of work that isn't needed if the positions can be filled in January 2022. Being part of the PTA is incredibly rewarding and fun too – particularly when you see first-hand how much children enjoy the events planned or enjoy the resources and equipment bought with PTA funds.

Your PTA raises approximately £25,000 per year

The PTA funds all the Forest School sessions your children enjoy throughout the year, provides many classroom books and resources, pays for workshops and experiences such as Lego robotics, Opera Brava theatre and a Christmas Panto. The PTA also contributes to larger items such as refitting the ICT Suite, building the Outdoor Classroom and adventure play equipment for the school field.

Your PTA hosts Christmas & Summer Fairs, cakes sales, Christmas Shopping Day, themed trails in the School Woods, Discos and Film Nights to name but a few. All these will cease if new parents/carers don't put themselves forward to stand for Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer and Secretary.

CHAIR:

Directs committee meetings and AGM

Acts as a point of liaison with Mrs MacGregor and PTA

Works with event sub-committees to make sure preparations for events are progressing

Represents PTA at school events, such as new Reception parents evening Manages Classlist

Writes termly newsletter

VICE CHAIR:

Liaises with Class Reps



Updates Classlist with event dates Stands in for Chair when unavailable for meetings Supports Chair where needed

TREASURER:

Prepares annual accounts and returns to the Charity Commission Liaises with external auditor Prepares finance reports for committee meetings Supervises bank account, manages, and records expenses Prepares floats for events, banks takings You DO NOT need to be a qualified accountant to take on this role!

SECRETARY:

Issues agendas and organises venues for committee meetings & AGM Prepares and circulates minutes for above meetings Ensures insurance is paid Maintains up to date list of Trustees with Charity Commission

ALL these roles can be job shares and no prior knowledge is needed – a full handover will be given.

ALL current committee members have multiple children and all but one work either full or part time – all committee roles can fit round your family and current commitments.
